ORAL JUDGMENT OF JUDGE M M MASON

- [1] The sentencing hearing for this matter was held on 26 May 2023 where an end point for the fine was set at \$201,250.
- [2] The hearing was adjourned to 23 June 2023 and then finally until 17 August 2023 for submissions and supporting documentation regarding the defendant's financial capacity or ability to pay the fine.
- [3] It is accepted by the parties that the reduction of any fine is discretionary, that there should be clear evidence of an inability to pay before a fine is reduced and that the Court may look to the shareholder/s of a company to assess whether it would exercise its discretion.

[4] I have received updated submissions from both parties. Of relevance are the

affidavits sworn by Mr Jay Shaw dated 25 May 2023 and 16 August 2023. After

receiving the financial information provided to him by the defendant he states that the

defendant appears to have financial capacity to pay a fine at the level sought by

Worksafe. He states that they have the capacity to pay over five years.

[5] I am satisfied that the defendant has had every opportunity to provide financial

records to Mr Shaw for review. The defendant has not filed any submissions

challenging the statement made by Mr Shaw.

[6] There is no clear evidence of an inability for the defendant to pay a fine.

[7] The are no reductions made to the fine. The fine is \$201,250 and is to be paid

over five years.

[8] I confirm the other orders made in my sentencing decision.

[9] What I have previously ordered is:

(a) Final suppression of victim's name and occupation.

(b) I have entered the conviction.

(c) \$710 consequential loss order in favour of the victim.

(d) \$20,000 reparation order as per the schedule.

(e) Cost of the legal fees, \$3,671.
