CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCE: UPDATING APPLICATIONS

Certificate of Competence (CoC) holders in the extractives industry were required to update their CoC by 1 January 2017.

From 1 January 2017, if you did not update your current CoC, you will need to comply with the requirements of a new applicant to obtain a current CoC. This will include completing the required unit standards, be a fit and proper person, hold a current first aid certificate and complete an oral examination.

The following table and chart set out results from December 2015 to December 2016.


